



HOW TO VOTE BY MAIL

This information is from the Bexar County Elections officials:

1. Applications for a ballot can be sent as early as 60 days prior to the election and no later than 11 days prior to the election.
2. Mailing ballots will begin in or around October 13 (the beginning of Early Voting).
3. **Complete** your ballot, **sign** the ballot, **seal** the ballot, **mail** ASAP (as soon as possible). Do NOT wait.
4. Once the ballot is received in the Elections office mail room, the ballot will be scanned. The ballot board meets to verify signatures, so it is critical that voters sign the ballot envelope and as well as the ballot.
5. Voters can call this department at **210-335-8160** to confirm that their ballot has been received.
6. Ballots must at least be postmarked by November 3, although their voicemail says the ballot must be received by that date. (Mail early to avoid this situation.)
7. If voters decide to vote in person instead of by mail, they can call the Elections office (210-335-8683) and cancel their ballot by mail or have the judge at the voting site call the Elections office.
8. We must push to **VOTE** Early, **SIGN** Ballot, **MAIL** Early.
