Who to Believe?

About 3½ years ago, I recall newspapers around the country endorsing the most qualified woman to be POTUS by 98% over a very flawed businessman (losing \$100 million/year for 10 years). All newspapers are fact checked by several individuals and typically have what's best for their communities as their editorial opinions. No wonder current POTUS said 'Don't believe the media'. But he does want you to watch his advisors, Fox news, his sound box. The Washington Post has documented over 16,000 lies to date and still counting. What's disturbing is Fox ratings are still solid compared to mainstream media. Don't facts matter?
