

Legislation from 87th Session

Texas H.B. 1927 Constitutional Carry--H.B. 1927 gets rid of the license requirement and allows eligible Texans 21 years and older to tote a gun if it's in a holster.

- **Texas H.B. 9--** enhances the criminal penalty to a state jail felony offense for anyone who knowingly blocks an emergency vehicle or obstructs access to a hospital or health care facility.
- **Texas H.B. 1900--** freezes property tax revenues for cities with a population over 250,000 that defund the police.
- **Texas H.B. 2366--** enhances criminal penalties for the use of laser pointers and creates an offense for the use of fireworks to harm or obstruct the police.
- **Texas S.B. 23--**requires voter approval to reduce law enforcement budgets in counties with a population of more than one million.
- **Texas S.B. 9--**a measure that would prohibit in Texas abortions as early as six weeks and open the door for almost any private citizen to sue abortion providers and others.
