Biden and the Democrats Legislative Accomplishments

The <u>Inflation Reduction Act</u> is expected to clear the House later this week on a glide path to President Biden's signature. It will join a list of hard-fought legislation shaping the U.S. economy, society and foreign policy for decades to come: <u>The American Rescue Plan</u> (COVID stimulus), <u>The Infrastructure and Jobs Act</u>, <u>confirmation</u> of the <u>first Black female Supreme Court justice</u>, <u>gun safety legislation</u>, <u>CHIPS</u> (semiconductor manufacturing and U.S. competitiveness with China), <u>NATO expansion</u> to include Finland and Sweden, and <u>veterans' health care expansion</u>.

The right wing attacks are part of a decades-long effort by two conservative oilman and part-time preachers who want to destroy Texas' K-12 education system as we know it. Tim Dunn and Farris Wilks have long supported the most right wing, anti-public education candidates.

Republicans block cap on insulin costs for many Americans from Democratic deal. *NBC*

Republican senators on Sunday (August 7) voted down a cap on the price of insulin in the private market, removing it from Democrats' sweeping climate and economic package. Democrats had tried to preserve the provision to cap insulin costs at \$35 for private insurers, but that vote failed 57-43, with seven Republicans voting with them to keep the insulin cost cap in the bill, three short of what was needed. Of course, Texas' Sen. John Cornyn and Sen. Ted Cruz both voted against lower the cost of insulin.
