He is perhaps best remembered for his postwar words, “First they came for the socialists, and I did not speak out ...”

First They Came ...

First they came for the Native Americans, and I did not speak out—because I was not a Native American.

Then they came for people of color, and I did not speak out—because I was not a person of color.

Then they came for women, and I did not speak out—because I was not a woman.

Then they came for me—and there was no one left to speak for me.
